### **Parent Questions**

- Q: What is the lunchtime supervision, kids are running around while they should be in their seats

A: there is 1 teacher to 3-4 classes, staff are discussing what can be done to keep kids in their seats for the 30min lunch break

- Q: What is being done to discourage touching at recess
   A: The staff regularly remind the students to keep social distancing and hands are sanitized prior to exiting the building at recess as well as prior to re-entering after recess
- Q: Is class D2L kept current

A: Teachers are to load everything onto D2L in case of class shutdowns, should be an active site. Can we used to keep up with assignments if child is home for a few days

- Q: Is the amount of homework provided in Grades 7 & 8 appropriate to get the kids ready for Grade 9

A: Teachers are following the HCDSB Homework Policy and only give if it is purposeful, it is recognized that this doesn't get kids ready for High School but also the homework level in High School will vary per stream. Additionally elementary school has the full year to finish the work while High School was 10 week semesters

Q: Will I be able to change the learning of my child from in school to virtual if the numbers go crazy after the change cut-off date
 A: Virtual Classes are capped as well so there might not be room to switch but each case would be looked at individually
 October Deadline was Oct 1, the reorganization will be on October 13<sup>th</sup> with classes starting October 19<sup>th</sup>

# Weekday Lunches

- Pizza Day is not a current option until there is a safe way
- Lunchbox and milk program waiting to hear back from Board, Mr. Cacciola will ask at the next Administration meeting
- Looking at bringing back the Breakfast Program as a pre-packaged Grab & Go
- HFFT Snack bins should be back in classrooms in October with pre-packaged healthy snacks

## School Generated Funds

- \$10K was used to buy new Chrome Books, this are currently backlogged and not yet received
  - Didn't have to spend school funds for the Learning Commons or Gym
    - Received curtains for the stage
    - School Board helped offset new shelving as we weren't a new school but a consolidation so started with more books
    - Initial renovation funds were used for the Gum Padding (\$15K) and Scoreboard (\$5K)

### Halloween

- Dance-a-thon isn't feasible and be able to maintain social distancing, no parents are allowed in the school
- We still have school generated funds from last year so this isn't needed as a fundraiser
- Prizes are not feasible, online gift cards not as exciting for kids
- Whatever forms are needed would need to be all virtual
- Will reconvene after Thanksgiving, Oct 17th
