#### Kiss and Ride

## **Boundary Review Process:**

Milton #3 Boundary:

- Assessing Boundary option for Milton #3 High School- slated to open Sept 2022
- Still awaiting funding announcement from MOE but strongly anticipating announcement soon
- Construction to level ground has started
- None of the boundary option affect St Scholastica as we would be connected to Jean Vanier in all scenarios being considered

Interim Milton #3 Plan:

• To hold students from Milton #3 Boundary

- Need to assess option for plans starting 2021 to 2022 School Year
- Options are EC Drury, Jean Vanier 6 period day to accommodate over 3000 students and 60 portables and Burlington Vacant Schools Lester B Pearson or Robert Baitman
- Lester B Pearson is currently preferred by the community
- Working group is still concerned on what we are presenting to the community and therefore asked for the community meeting to be deferred to finalize

## Community BBQ- move to June 2021?:

- We are cancelling the BBQ in September- too soon
- Can be successful in June as well
- We voted as a council to have the BBQ in June- June 3 2021 is the tentative date

## **Fundraising:**
