Learning Environment Switches

The Board is currently asking for data from Principals around the numbers of families who are asking to switch learning environments (between survey periods) now that we have returned to in-person learning. As of now, the next survey will occur before March Break for a switch date after March Break. Parents are asked to let Mr. Hawken know if that it is their wish to switch prior to the next survey date. If students are not attending school in the meantime there is a Voluntary Synchronous Learning Request Process that needs to begin by first contacting Mr. Hawken.
