

Parking Lot and “Kiss and Ride” Safety Tips

Please consider these tips to keep everyone safe during morning drop-offs.

- Kiss & Ride is a single lane **ONLY**. Drop your child(ren) off **ONLY** in the “Kiss and Ride” traffic pattern – NOT in the thru-lane along-side of the “Kiss and Ride”.
- Pull your car forward to continue the movement of vehicles through in the “Kiss and Ride” lane.
- Make sure your child enters and exits your car on the PASSENGER/SCHOOL SIDE, **NOT** on the driver’s side. Exiting on the driver’s side would put students in a very close proximity of the thru-lane traffic.
- Do not pass other cars in line or cut into “Kiss and Ride” lane. Vehicles should follow in sequence to exit **both** the “Kiss and Ride” and the thru lane.
- Refrain from reversing your car in the “Kiss and Ride” area.
- If your child(ren) requires assistance with exiting the car, and collecting personal belongings, PLEASE use the parking lot. Parking your car in the parking lot to assist your child(ren) will help support the traffic flow of “Kiss and Ride”.
- If you are walking your child(ren) from the parking lot to the school gate, please cross with them AT THE STOP SIGN and NOT in between the cars in the “Kiss and Ride” lane.
- Please plan ahead! Rushing can cause accidents and stress.
- Please remember we all have a common goal when it comes to student safety. Let’s continue to be courteous and respectful for the wellbeing and safety of our children.
