Subject: Implementation of No Stopping Zone on Savoline Boulevard

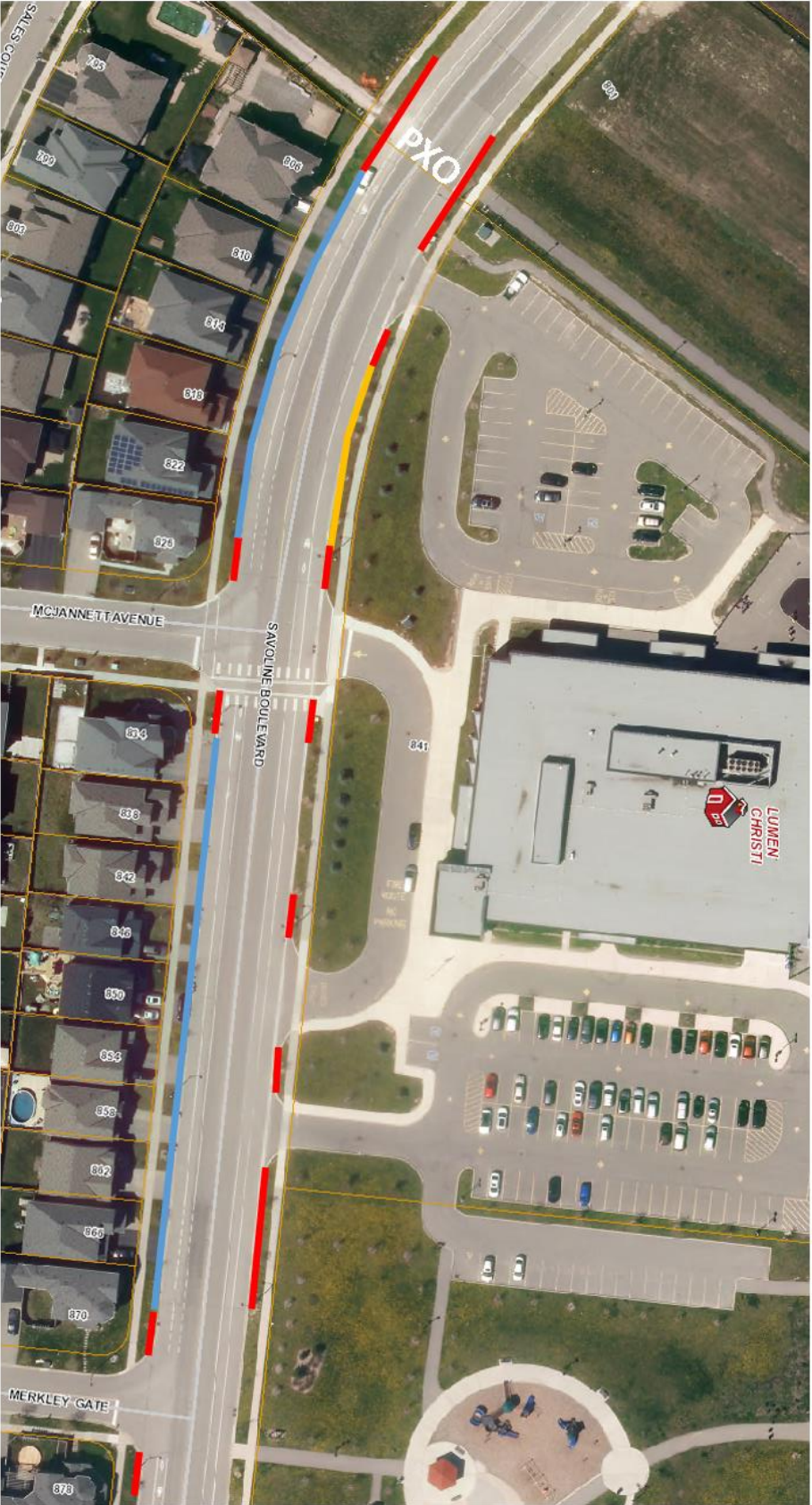
A new Pedestrian Crossover (PXO) was recently installed on Savoline Boulevard and the Union Gas Trail (just north of McJannett Avenue) to aid pedestrian in crossing the roadway safely. This crossing has been heavily utilized by students and parents walking to Lumen Christi Catholic Elementary School.

Due to the large volume of parents dropping off/picking up students during entrance and dismissal times Savoline Boulevard becomes congested and all on-street parking is utilized. It has been observed that vehicles parking on the east side of Savoline Boulevard between the most northerly driveway to the school and McJannett Avenue obstruct the view of pedestrians waiting to cross from the east side of the PXO for northbound motorists. This is largely due to the curvature of the road.

In order to ensure pedestrian safety at the PXO the Town of Milton will be extending the existing no-stopping zone to include the east side of Savoline Boulevard between the PXO and McJannett Avenue (see map). This change will eliminate five on-street parking spots and will be effective as of Monday October 1st. Parents are encouraged to watch for new signage indicating the above and obey all parking bylaws.

Parents are always encouraged to park a block away and walk with their kids to school. This will increase the overall level of safety for all road users and promotes active transportation and a healthy lifestyle.
