1. Curriculum Committee

Proposed Mandate

The Curriculum Committee works in conjunction with the School Principal to implement strategies and programs that support effective instructional practice and improved student learning. Strategies may include financial support for programs and/or parent engagement activities which contribute to student academic success.

Goals for 2017-18:

- 1. Host a "Math Night" parent engagement event in February 2018. Includes a presentation for parents by the Board Math Consultant regarding "old" vs "new" Math and how to use Math Manipulatives to support your child's learning at home, followed by an opportunity to visit several interactive demo stations with your child.
- 2. Recommend strategies to improve communication within the feedback loop between student, teacher and parents, to reinforce subsequent improvements in student work.

2. Council Improvement Committee

Overview:

The Council Improvement Committee is about the correlating and implementation of manual in what is required for all school and council activities and events.

What is involved?

The Council Improvement Committee is not just about tactical coordination and execution across the various school and /or council events. It is about working together to bring awareness and education to our parent council and community on the daily life at OLP.

Initiatives:

The following are examples of what initiatives over and above the 'tactical coordination and execution of events under this committee:

- 1) Standard Project Template that can be applied to any event which details what key milestones and processes are followed in the successful execution of an event
- 2) Documentation
- a. All standard, repeatable events need to have a background description document on what it is, if it is a school or council event, etc. so that should new members of council know what it is all about and the expectations
- 3) Calendar of Events Management

- 3) Create a mechanism to understand the school availability and any supporting by-laws for introduction of new activities to help build 2019 goals.

4. Fundraising Committee

Overview:

This committee is about the planning and execution of the One Key Fundraising event and other smaller fundraising events that bring the OLP Community together in supporting our school and community at large. Traditionally the One Key Fundraising event has occurred every year in the fall, and has been a Dance-a-thon. There has been discussion and feedback about changing this and in order to be effective and execute something new, this is something that takes a year in advance planning.

What is involved?

This group will look at planning and tactical execution, but will also have the goal this year to bring the ideas and research to the Council by end of year so that planning can start in 2018 for the One Key Fundraising event.

Brainstorming, research, presentation of ideas and getting approval are all part of this Committee's mandate for 2017-2018.
