#### Concussion Protocol

- All teachers were advised in early fall about the appropriate procedures.
- A concussion is a brain injury that is caused by a blow to the head, face, neck, or body that can cause a sudden jarring of the head. Even what seems to be a mild bump to the head can be serious.

Research indicates that a concussion can affect a student's school performance in both cognitive activities (school work) and physical activities (physical education program/interschool activities). Research also indicates that engaging in cognitive and /or physical activities, while a child has a suspected and/or diagnosed concussion, can worsen concussion symptoms and delay the student's recovery.

- Concussions that occur in school-organized activities will be documented and managed through the Board's Concussion Protocol. Through the collaborated efforts of the school team, partnered with the parent(s)/guardian(s) and the medical support team, the student will participate in the steps of the Return to Learn and the Return to Physical Activity plans. The student's progress will be documented/tracked and continuously monitored through frequent communication between the school and home, until full-recovery has occurred.
- Students with a suspected concussion will be brought to the school health provider and asked for symptoms following the C2 form.
- Depending on the answers, parents will be called to pick up the student and asked to closely monitor the child for a period of 24 hours following the form of symptoms provided.
- If any changes in the condition occur, parents are advised to go to health care provider immediately.
- If nothing occurs within the 24 hour period, parents are required to complete a sign off form and the student is able to return to school.
- If within 24 hours a concussion is diagnosed, we follow the C-4, 'Return to Learn' form and the student will be off for at least 5 days.
- Once the student is ready to return to school, activities will be reduced and the student will follow the steps of the return to learn form until full participation is possible.
- The timeline depends on the student & the sign off on sheets will be completed in collaboration with the parent.
- Depending on the severity, this process could take 6 month to a year in order to get back to full activity.
- We are very strictly following the School Board's guidelines.

- We had a few incidents this school year with most not being a concussion.
- We have experienced 3 concussions this year so far.

- We provide a yellow first aid sheet for our parent if no concussion is suspected.
- We regularly review our supervisor procedures but accidents unfortunately do happen.
- We do our best to be proactive in identifying and removing any potential unsafe situations.
- Wagons used for the FDK yard have been removed until reviewed again and proper procedures (i.e. wagon safety) can be reviewed.
- The FDK school yard was discussed and suggestions were made to move the FDK children to the grass area instead of the concrete. Unfortunately the grass area is also used by other grades which is not feasible.
- Risk assessment occurs as per HCDSB safety guidelines.
