- Mr. Shannon handed out notes to everyone for an ice-breaker activity
- Each member shared one or more interesting facts about themselves, their kids and another council member

3. Structure & Roles of Catholic School Advisory Council & Determination of School Advisory Council Chairs & Council Roles/Committees

- Mr. Starr provided a brief outline of the structure & some of the roles
- The Catholic School Council of Queen of Heaven School is an advisory council to the school's administration that provides feedback or input on various decisions pertaining to the school.
- The council is comprised of parents of our school community, as well as staff & community representatives
- The ultimate goal of our Catholic School Council is to support the school in best serving the needs of our students and broader community
- As a parent representative we serve all parents in the community
- We will meet at least 4 times a year
- An agenda is created before each meeting (topics may include but are not limited to Catholicity, School Improvement Planning, community events, fundraising budgets, areas of priority for our school, committee reports)
- Member should provide anything they would like to discuss beforehand so it can be added to the agenda and there is time to have answers available if need be

- Previous minutes will be approved by attending council members at the beginning of each meeting
- We will use the consensus model of decision making and if necessary council members may vote on items
- The principal and vice-principals do not vote
- Only official school council members are able to vote
- Consensus is finding the highest level of agreement without dividing participants into factions. It is an important tool, but may not be needed for all decisions
- Consensus is group decision making, based on willingness to consent and support, rather than having a winning and losing side by voting
- It allows ownership of ideas by all School Council members as being the best choice
- Consensus may be sometimes difficult to reach, so not every decision will meet with everyone's complete approval
- Mr. Starr suggests to perhaps elect an experienced member as chair as well as a new person as co-chair
- For all sub-committees it is OK to draw other parents in, the more the better to problem solve and get things done

- There are lots of different ways to volunteer, not just as part of the council; a high volunteer rate and student success goes hand in hand
- Addressing the question to use Facebook to communicate to volunteers to keep parents up-to-date, Mr. Starr stresses that no Queen of Heaven logos/branding can be used on outside sites

- The report recaps details such as

5. Budget Update

- We have \$14,000
- Proposal shared by Mr. Starr
 - We have 7 classes with no dedicated iPads (approx. \$3,500)
 - o Many sports uniforms are well used and could use replacing (approx. \$3000)
 - We would like to provide a dedicated bin for each classroom (x 38) with playground equipment (approx. \$3800)
 - We would like some Math manipulatives for all classrooms (approx. \$3000 \$4000)
- Suggestion was made also for some Sensory Equipment (\$2000) which reduced the Math manipulatives from \$3000 - \$4000 to \$2000; allowing \$2000 for each
- Christian motioned to accept details as above (including Sensory Equipment)
- Seconded by Bonnie
- Vote: ALL IN FAVOUR
- Sports uniforms are board approved/sanctioned and we have some that we currently use
- Sports equipment companies give discounts to schools to purchase playground equipment
- Tracey suggests to use the baskets we have for the basket raffle to store equipment; something more durable might be needed
- The suggestion was made to ask for items for classroom bins as a donation from

- parents as we do for the basket raffles
- Maybe we could have a list of items needed and have volunteers separate them and distribute evenly to all classrooms
- Kerstin adds that teachers in the U.S. have lists to contribute on Amazon, almost like GoFundMe or a baby registry
- Mr. Starr suggests that we can maybe start with the funds we have voted on and then set something up to replenish the equipment when needed
