## **Respect for our School Washrooms**

Thank you to the many parents who have taken a few minutes to chat with your children about respectful treatment of school property at Queen of Heaven, particularly our school washrooms. As we emailed earlier, we have been experiencing troubling vandalism within our school washrooms. Our hard-working custodian Mr. Parra has been called to clean washroom stalls continuously due to excrement being wiped on the walls of the washroom stalls. Last week we posted signs on the washroom entrance wall indicating the washroom use is being closely monitored with our admin staff and Mr. Parra making efforts to pass by the washrooms as many times as possible throughout the day in the hopes children become aware and comforted of caring extra vigilance in monitoring our washrooms. In addition, we continue to make daily p.a. announcements reminding our students to treat our property and one another with dignity, kindness and respect. The recent washroom signage depicting a camera and words stating the washrooms are being monitored was not meant to imply cameras are in the school - they ARE NOT. The only cameras in elementary Halton Catholic schools are located at the main front entrance of the school to monitor the front door buzzer. We have replaced the camera icon signage with simple words reminding our students to treat our washrooms respectfully. Your ongoing conversations and reminders at home are greatly appreciated as we work together to help instill the values of kindness and respect in our children. Thank you!
