

Rapid Antigen Screening Kits- all of our in-person learners took home a Rapid Antigen Screening Kit for voluntary use over the Christmas holiday. The rapid antigen screening kits have been provided by the Government of Ontario for every student who attends in-person learning at a publicly funded school. These kits may be used by any student, regardless of their vaccination status, however, should **only be used when a child is asymptomatic** (does not have any symptoms of COVID-19) and has not had any exposure to a confirmed case of COVID-19. Please note, your child's participation in the **rapid antigen screening process is voluntary** and is not a required action for return to school after the Christmas break. Thank you for your ongoing support and care as we strive to keep our communities safe and our schools open for in-person learning.
