Business Arising from our last Meeting:

- a) <u>PRO Grant:</u> Lorraine B. confirmed that the application has been submitted for a Numeracy Night and she has pre-booked "The Learning Tree" for October 17, 2018. The HCDSB has added an extra component to the grant of to ensure the goal of diversity and more parent engagement is met. It was suggested if transportation could be provided to families for families who do not have mode of transportation to the school. The 2018/2019 council will make this determination.
- b) <u>BBQ Review: May 31, 2018:</u> Kelly W. provided a summary: The wristbands, raffle tickets and prizes were a great success. This year we profited approximately \$5K vs. \$2K last year. The improvements to this year's event were well received and proved to be beneficial in the success.
- c) <u>Student Council Updates</u>: Kelly W. (VP) advised that the garden that council has planted is continuing to grow. Also the Grade 7's will be the volunteers at the grade 8 graduation. As well, next year special factions such as "liturgical team", "tech team" and "hospitality team" will be added.
- d) <u>Parking Issues</u>: Lorraine B. reported that since she has requested presence from the Town of Oakville and added staff monitoring, we have seen improvements to the problems.

Financial Report

Emilia D. reported. At year end we have an excess of funds, as a result Lorraine B. has purchased 14 new laptops (approximately \$9,000). As a council we agreed to increase the budget next year for compassionate needs, as well expenses for the grad awards and graduation food have not yet been posted.

As we have approximately \$20,000 in funds remaining, minus the \$9K for the 14 laptops and the GST/HST payments to be posted, a motion was put forth by Elisabeth M. and second by Kelly W. to purchase the following from the proposed Wish list:

• For our 2 x Grade 4 classrooms; flexible seating and fidget stools (approximately \$200/each), depending on the amount of excess funds remain. Total ask: \$2,000

Lorraine B. also advised that our school is planning to put on "Seussical the Musical" for the 2018/2019 school year. Ticket sales for the events do cover much of the cost, however a choreographer and lighting equipment with a cost of \$5,000 each will need to be planned.
