>A member shall recognize and respect the personal integrity of each member of the school community.

A member shall treat all other members with respect and allow for diverse opinions to be shared without interruption.

A member shall encourage a positive environment in which individual contributions are encouraged and valued.

A member shall acknowledge democratic principles and accept the consensus of the Catholic School Council.

A member shall respect the confidential nature of some school business and respect limitations this may place on the operation of the Catholic School Council. > A member shall not disclose confidential information.

- A member shall limit discussions at Catholic School Council meetings to matters of concern to the school community as a whole.
- A member shall use established communication channels when questions or concerns arise.
- A member shall promote high standards of ethical practice within the school community.
- > A member shall declare any conflict of interest.
- A member shall not accept any payment or benefit financially through Catholic School Council
