area!

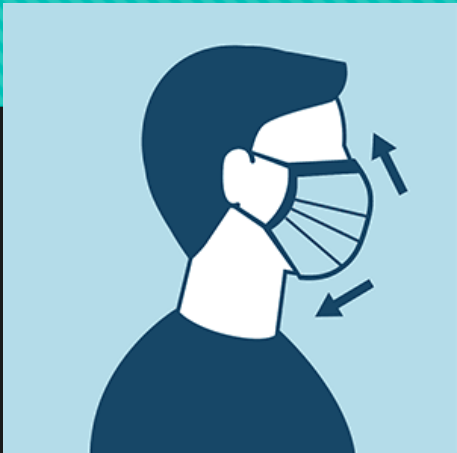
**ONLY PLAY WITH THE CHILDREN FROM
