ACHIEVING:

CURRICULUM & UPDATEs

- SIP Goals: Safe School and Equity & Inclusion, Mental Health & Well-Being, and Numeracy have been our focus to begin the year along with continuing the Halton Public Health guidelines for COVID and "Reopening Schools"
- Cross Panel Met virtually to finalize plans for our Intermediates and Corpus Christi, with a number of activities to be held throughout the year either virtually, or resources delivered to us for students to complete with their classroom teacher; also working on joint FOS parent piece with Chris Vollum (presentation to intermediates during the day, followed by an evening presentation virtually to our parents within our family of schools)
- Next PA Day is Friday, November 27th for Parent/Teacher Interviews still waiting on direction from the Board about how this will look virtually, so information will come out once we hear more
- MathUp underway, focus on the new Math curriculum, virtual presentations and workshops for teachers
- Reading interventions: RTI has started as well as our Empower program
- Progress Reports going home November 24th
- Grade 4 CCAT (Canadian Cognitive Testing) starting the week of November 16th through to December 4th (run by our SERTs and the classroom teachers)
- IEPs for first term went home October 20th
- Anti-Racism workshops continued virtually for our staff, will be including these learnings in our Equity and Inclusion plans
- Teacher Candidates in 6 classrooms started today until December 17th from Brock University

- Continuing with routines following COVID guidelines (cohorts, zones, recesses split, no equipment, washroom logs, seating plans, essential visitors only)
