- 1. **Student Presentation** Derek Pinto Reading of his Poem
 - Derek read his poem. Shared that he was inspired by Amanda Gorman from inauguration to write poems. Amazing feedback from council members.

2. Health & Safety Update Students & Staff in the Building (Mrs. Le Conte)

- Ministry has permitted students with special needs to work with principals to come into the school if they cannot be accommodated online. We have 5-6 students who come into the building each day. SERTS and EAs are permitted in building to support these students. PPEs and self-screening protocol are implemented and followed every day by all staff members who enter building. Staff have a new form to fill in each day- confirming daily screening.
- Waiting on further update from Minister Lecce regarding returning to school (i.e. PPE protocols for when we return to schools).

- Moving forward, St. Benedict will follow the recommendation that both staff and students will wear masks, when social distancing cannot be maintained (i.e.outdoor recess, in all hallways, etc). —
- Waiting to see if there will be changes in mask requirements for students. Staff required to wear board approved medical masks.
- At the school level, when the government, public health, and/or the ministry makes decisions, we find out when announcements are made to the public.
