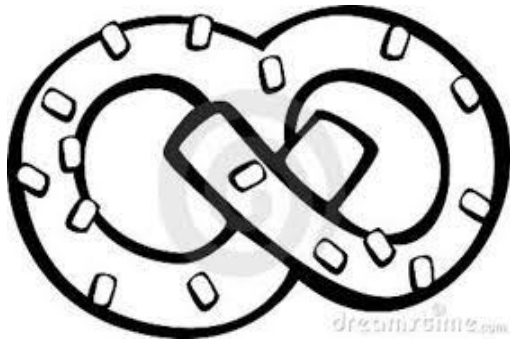


Dear St. Dominic families,
