Discussion:

- Outdoor Classroom Grants (Paul): Lily has been talking to Oakville Parks & Rec and discussing getting logs for seating. Two seating areas will be focused on to start: 1) expanding the existing armour stone circle in the grassy area across from of the main doors with more armour stone and log seating as well as more trees added for shade, 2) constructing a second seating area in the back (north-west) corner, using the existing perimeter trees for shade, and possibly adding more as needed. As there is no structure proposed at this time, a grant is not necessary at this time. The plan will be reviewed and reassessed next year to determine whether a structure is needed.
- Active Chefs (Selena): an update from Lidija will come next meeting, but any ingredients used in the event will be allergy-friendly, and an ingredient list will be shared prior to the event.
- Movie Night (Kelly): Possible movies were chosen based on parent-friendly reviews using <u>www.commonsensemedia.com</u>, then the students voted from the list and decided on Inside Out and Alexander and the Horrible Terrible No Good Very Bad Day. Movie Night is April 11th, and the forms were sent home via email. Popcorn and water will be sold the night of the event.
- Pretzels (Paul): forms were sent home, payment via cash only as cash online for this small amount would be counterproductive when considering fees.
- Questions about online forms being emailed:
 - Is there a better format for multiple attachments (in the emails, there is only a small space between hyperlinks which can prevent some parents from noticing that there are multiple links)
 - If we are going towards a more environmentally friendly method of communicating with forms being sent via email, can parents also have the option to reply digitally, for example, to sign up for Movie Night. It was discussed that there are privacy/security issues with this. It was also suggested that we could look into solutions again.
