

Sacrament of Confirmation 2021-2022

Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation will begin this Fall for those in grade 7 and beyond who are **registered** parishioners in Saint Dominic Parish. Those who are not registered will need a letter of permission from their Pastor.

Registrations

- A Copy of the Candidate's Baptismal Certificate will be needed, Confirmandi will not be able to receive the sacrament without a copy of this certificate
- *Registrations must be submitted to the Parish Office*

Celebration of Confirmation

Tentative dates scheduled from May 3 - 6. These dates will be confirmed later in the year assessing the pandemic situation and protocols from the Diocese of Hamilton.

St. Dominic and St. James Parish may hold different dates, however, please be advised that you are to follow the direction upon which parish you are registered.

Service Projects

The gifts of the Holy Spirit are for the good of the community in Christian Service, therefore, the Candidate is asked to prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation by doing a **Service Project** of **20 hours.**

- Ideally: 5 hours at Home, 5 hours at School, 5 hours at Church, and 5 hours in the Community
- Some flexibility is allowed, if you do more hours in one area than another
- To keep track of hours please submit a signed letter to your teachers, from the appropriate contact indicating the number of hours served and date(s).

SUGGESTIONS FOR SERVICE PROJECTS & SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT

The purpose of a service project is to show the candidate's desire to make a serious commitment to Christ and his Church by serving others generously. Most candidates considered the Service Project the best part of preparing for Confirmation.

The wonderful aspect about service is that the rewards are tremendous! When we serve, we love, and we become less self-centered, less focused on our own selfish wants. The more we serve, the more we love and eventually both become a way of life.

People who serve are joy-filled, peace-filled people, who, in their service, come to see the face of God in those they serve. We want you to discover the joy of service!

Parents, sponsors, teachers, and the Pastoral Team may help candidates to choose a realistic service project and to encourage the candidates to complete the service to which they commit themselves.

<u>Home</u>

• Honour your parents by offering to help any way you can! Babysitting, cleaning, etc.

<u>School</u>

• Teach, tutor or coach a team sport, hobby or favourite subject, reading buddy, school lunch day, help set up in auditorium for various activities, join School Choir.
