- Thanks to all parents and staff for the amazing work being done by staff and parents to support their students
- Ms. Purdy is on a leave of absence until the middle of February which has left a gap for the class regetting a steady grade 4 class supply teacher
- Per Ministry, teachers in training may now fill in for absent teachers
- Everything the children work on is evaluated and assessed focus on most consistent and a triangulation of data
- School donated over \$800.00 in gift cards for the GBB plus \$150.00 from the poinsettia fundraiser thanks to Vicki for the suggestion
- Uncertain about the return to school and the specifics surrounding the enhanced guidelines that may
 be implemented. Best guess is that students will have to wear masks outside
- Direction from Public Health gym classes should be outside as much as possible therefore each class
 has indoor gym once per week and they have dedicated equipment as well as wipes for shared
 equipment. Gym is disinfected between uses. The kids will likely be required to wear masks during
 gym class (at SFA we've been doing this anyway)
- Edge Imaging has changed their management structure and we currently don't know when/ if we'll be able to have photos done. We have already signed up for the "green screen" option
- Hoodies are ready to go just waiting to get the kids measured/ sized up per Mark
- Grade 7/8's trips are completely off the table
- Graduation ceremony is uncertain

- Confirmation this year will not be with the Bishop; it will be done through Father Dave and Father Hayden if we are allowed to gather
- Grade 2's only had First Holy Communion in the fall
- Town is redoing Sinclair and will be putting in a parking lane and a sidewalk
- When/ if we return to school, we MAY be able to receive ashes on Ash Wednesday (sprinkled) pending approval from Public Health and upon reopening
- World Day of the Sick February 11th
