ACHIEVING

- Unsure what will happen with in person learning as of June 2nd
- Teachers are doing a great job! Focusing of triangulation of data observations/ conversations and product. Utilizing break out rooms to assist with the learning piece
- Grade 5 & 6 are starting a coding online pilot project with McMaster University, first class begins Tuesday May 17
- Board has provided significant funding that has been spent on outdoor benches, play equipment, planters for kindergarten
- Kindergarten orientation was completed last week via Teams Live; approximately 35 students
- Board is installing an outdoor classroom along fence line of parking lot and will be fully accessible
- Gym floor is being replaced

- Kindergarten yard is great but grass didn't grow so AstroTurf will be installed
- Grade 8 grad tentatively booked for June 23rd as a drive thru format to take place at the school along with online pre-recorded ceremony
- Board is working on cleaning up the entrance to seal off where the birds are nesting
- Total number of students registered for next year
 - Current anticipated we're at 351 students
 - 11 indicated to be online, leaving 340 in person learning

BELIEVING

- Catholic Education week was a huge success
- Guest speaker spoke to mental health etc.

BELONGING

- Grade 1-3 max of 20 w/ allowance of up to 23
- Grade 4-8 average of 25
- Kindergarten is capped at 25 with one teacher and one ECE, or 15 with one teacher
- We may have to create a fourth kindergarten class of 15 students with 1 educator and contingencies have been made to accommodate this
- School Equity Walk
 - Reviewed checks and balances and noted some areas of improvement
- Supporting our diverse community and raising the flag
 - Mark received approximately 6 emails from concerned community members urging him to go against the Board in this but he is not doing that
 - Review of diversity program

Budget

- A little over \$8000.00 after removing Food for Thought money and Technology donation
- Approximately 10 people signed up for FlipGive
