2019 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS -SIXTEEN MILE DRIVE AT COLTON WAY PRE-CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Please be advised that as part of the Town of Oakville's 2019 Intersection Improvements Project, an Intersection Pedestrian Signal (IPS) will be constructed on Sixteen Mile Drive at Colton Way.






WORK DETAILS

The intersection of Sixteen Mile Drive and Colton Way is currently under side road stop control. Pedestrian signalization of the intersection with a pedestrian crossing on the West side, underground wiring, and street-lighting will be implemented. **Construction will commence within 2 weeks.** Work will take approximately 2-4 weeks to complete.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The Town will make every effort to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Hours of work are from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm; Monday to Friday. There may be occasional work on weekends as required. Please note that hours of work may be altered to accommodate school traffic.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: Roadway access will be maintained at all times. In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there may be temporary road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Efforts will be made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and pedestrians.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traffic will be maintained in each direction with traffic flagging as required • Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone without consent from the Town is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work a traffic ticket will be issued.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with topsoil, sod and/or asphalt where required.</p>
