#### BACKPACK



Your child will need a **large** backpack that will be big enough to hold their lunch, mailbag, large library book, extra clothes etc.

#### SNACKS AND LUNCHES



Please send a healthy lunch and two snacks that are **NUT FREE** for your child. Students are unable to have products that also state they **"May Contain"** nuts.

In order to help your child decide on which food to eat, it may help them to label the containers (e.g. 1, 2, 3) for each of our meal times.



Some days your child may want more to eat than others, therefore you may consider offering them a couple of choices for each of the snack times. This will allow them to self-regulate their hunger needs throughout the day.

We do not have water fountains in our classrooms, therefore reusable water bottles work best. Juice boxes often cause spills and are a slipping hazard in the classroom.



#### COMMUNICATION

Ziploc bags or a Mailbag will be used to carry all necessary items to and from school. It will be used by both home and school to share information when necessary.

Please place in your child's backpack, a **complete** change of clothes to be left at school (socks, underwear, top and bottom). Please remember to replenish when used.

## FOOTWEAR

Your child will need a pair of <u>indoor shoes</u> that may be left at school. This helps to keep our indoor environment clean. The students participate in outdoor play and shoes can get quite dirty. Please have an appropriate pair of shoes for <u>outdoor</u> use that allows students to run and play safely. Velcro shoes allow students to be successful in independently getting ready if they are unable to tie shoe laces. Running shoes are best.
