An outbreak is considered when there are more than one individual is exposed to another individual. An epi linked: when someone contracts Covid-19 outside the school such as a family member or an extracurricular activity  Teachers are prepared to teach virtually (synchronous) if/when students are quarantined  If a whole class is quarantined then the class will shut down.
