Here is a quick overview of what is available for Grade 7-8 students. All online resources can be accessed with an Oakville Public Library card.

How to Register for a Library Card

If you live or attend school in Oakville and don't have an OPL library card, you can now register for one through email or telephone.

Select one option:

- Send us an email at oplreference@oakville.ca with your request; or
- Call us at 905-815-2039 and leave a voicemail, include your name and phone number.

Please allow 48 hours to process your registration. Currently, this library card will provide you with access to OPL's digital collections which includes eBooks, audiobooks, online resources, and more. Once the library resumes regular operations, we can provide you with a full-access library card.

All of our online resources can be accessed using your Oakville Public Library card and PIN number.

<u>TumbleBook Cloud Junior</u> offers an online collection for young readers that includes over 600 titles. This collection contains classics, graphic novels and National Geographic videos, many of which are paired with eBooks.

<u>Encyclopedia Britannica – Kids</u> provides separate search capabilities for elementary and middle school students and includes interactive exercises and activities, as well as links to magazine articles and clips.

<u>Hoopla</u> allows you to instantly stream or download movies, television shows, audiobooks and music.

<u>cloudLibrary</u> offers a growing collection of eBooks and audiobooks for adults, teens, and kids. Read and listen through the mobile or desktop app on your computer, smartphone, or tablet.
