New COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool

The Ontario government released a new online screening tool for schools – https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/. It is extremely important that parents do this self-screening test with their children BEFORE they come to school each day. Staff also do this assessment daily before coming to work. Let's all do our part to ensure the safety of all!

Mask Wearing

Thank you for reinforcing the importance of wearing masks with your children. They are doing an excellent job following this protocol and we appreciate your support. We would also kindly request that parents wear masks when they are dropping off or picking up their students when waiting at the gate or getting out of their cars. During these times, there are more people gathering outside of their cohorts. We need your continued support to avoid any lingering or social gatherings during both entry and dismissal times

Orange Shirt Day: Every Child Matters - Sept. 30th

September 30th is recognized as Orange Shirt Day. This day acknowledges the residential school system and recognizes the harm they did to Indigenous children's sense of self-esteem and wellbeing. We are encouraging our staff and students to wear orange shirts (uniform bottoms must be worn) to come together in the spirit of reconciliation and hope for generations of children to come.

Request to Change Learning Environment - Oct. 1

If you wish to change your child's learning environment by switching from remote learning to in-class instruction, or vice versa, you are asked to complete an online request form.

Important notes before you complete the online form:

- You are asked to submit a separate form for each child.
- You will need your child's Ontario Education Number (OEN) to submit this request. The OEN can be found on a recent report card.

- This online request form applies to elementary students ONLY. Requests for changes in the learning environment at the secondary school level should be sent to directly to your child's secondary school Principal.
- This form does not apply to homeschooling. If your child is currently being homeschooled and you would like to request a change to either in-class instruction or remote learning, please contact your Family of Schools Superintendent.

NOTE: Please do not complete this form unless you want to change your child's current learning environment – i.e. your child is currently attending in-class instruction and you want to switch to remote (online) learning in a virtual classroom.

The online form will remain open until 11:59 p.m. on Thursday, October 1, 2020.

Next Steps

Once the online form has closed, our staff will begin to work through the rescheduling process.

- Parents and guardians will **receive confirmation of the changes** to their children's learning environment during the **week of October 13**th.
- The changes will come into effect during the week of October 19, 2020.
