April 1st to 3rd: Participating students will decorate a shoebox.

April 6th: Shoeboxes will be filled by the students and sealed.

April 8th: The shoeboxes will be delivered to CFFC.

If you prefer to buy the items yourself, you can, just please make sure you have all the essential items mentioned at the beginning and fillers that will fill the box completely. Your child may bring in their shoe box on April 1st to decorate with the class, however, items need to be at school by April 6th at the latest. Your child can then fill their box and leave it unsealed for us to make sure everything is packed correctly. We will proceed to tape it with the rest of the boxes.
