We hope to have 100% participation by students and staff!

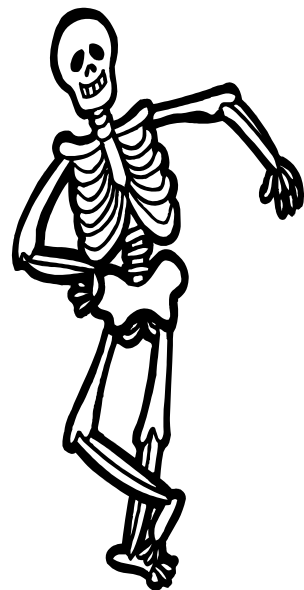
Costume considerations to be safe at school:

Costumes must not:

- Impair vision or breathing, there are no masks as students will be wearing masks for COVID-19 protocol;
- Present a trip hazard to the wearer or the bystander;
- Represent disfiguring injury or, to put it bluntly, "blood and guts";
- Promote themes or activities inappropriate for a Catholic elementary school;
- Be revealing or suggestive;
- Include weapons or replica weapons;
- Require staff to apply or remove costume pieces and/or make-up

Costumes must:

- Allow the student easy, **independent** access to the washroom. This is especially important for students from FDK to grade 2.
- Allow the student to wear sufficiently warm clothing over or under the costume as weather/temperature dictates for outdoor recess.
