Principal's Report

Catholic School Council Meeting #5 – April 17th, 2019

ACHIEVING

- Registrations are streaming in for next year. As of today, we are looking at a total of 354 (9 since last month's meeting) students from K-8. This is a stark contrast to where we started in September at approximately 220 students. I do foresee many new registrations between now and the first week of September though and feel that our number will likely be closer to 400 in September.
- Grade 3 and Grade 6 EQAO is approaching in May of this year. Our Grade 3 students will write the primary assessment over three days during the week of May 21st-24th and our Grade 6 students will write the junior assessment over three days during the week of May 27th-30th.
- Continuing with same focus areas of making student's thinking more visible and also running reading intervention programs (finishing with the second group of Grade 2's)
- Teachers participated in Professional Development this past Friday centered around Fractions and teaching this concept to students in more developmentally appropriate ways

BELIEVING

- Our Lenten Food Drive supporting "Food for Life" has wrapped up and the food donations will be picked up tomorrow. We thank Mrs. Pavelic and Mrs. McNabb's Kindergarten class, along with our Grade 8 Student Ambassadors for helping us to organize this for our school. We have asked "Food for Life" to distribute the food here in our own Milton community.
- On April 3rd, students in Grades 3-8 participated in Lenten confessions here in our school gym. Father Jim and four associate priests were here to assist
- Our Grade 7 and 8 students will be putting on a "Stations of the Cross" presentation tomorrow in our school gym at 1:30pm. All families are welcome to attend.
- Our official school opening and blessing celebration will also be taking place during
 Catholic Education Week on Tuesday, May 7th at 10:00AM. Please mark this date, as all

Catholic School Council members will be receiving a formal invitation to this event. Please join us if you can arrange to be present. Bishop Crosby will be coming to bless our classroom crosses and school areas.

BELONGING

- This area is still our main area of focus
- Leadership students from the Grade 12 Leadership program at Jean Vanier have started working with us on Tuesdays and Thursdays. On Tuesdays, they lead Daily Physical Activities (DPA) for twenty minutes in all Grade 1-8 rooms (just before lunch) and our Thursdays they run an intramural sports/games program for our Grade 7 and 8 students in the gym.
- Our Snack Bin program funded by a grant from Halton Food for Thought began the week of April 8th. It is going very well and has been well received by the students. We are managing the running of this program without the help of volunteers at this time. Mrs. Ceko (our Secretary) has had no problems finding time on Mondays to load the bins and on Fridays to take stock and clean them.
- We had our first of two lock down drills on April 9th. The students did a tremendous job and a few deficiencies were noted and have been rectified. Our next drill will take place before May 1st. Parents are ALWAYS sent an email to inform them that the event was a DRILL.
- A staff member from Halton Region came to do a waste presentation with our students on April 11th. She provided information to students on what items could be considered for the green cart, blue bin and/or garbage.
- Catholic Education Week is fast approaching. It is the week of May 6th-10th and the theme for this year is "Living as Joyful Disciples." A brochure will be coming home in the next week to advertise to parents an "Open House" time that they can feel free to drop into their child's class to take part in an activity.
