# **Principal's Report**

# Catholic School Council Meeting #1 - September 30th, 2019

#### **ACHIEVING**

- We are settled in classes after having to do two major re-organizations (one during the last week of August and the second on the first day of the second week of school)
- We have doubled in size: 220 in September of 2018 to 445 as of today
- Divisional assemblies were held during the first full week of school (Primary 1-3, Junior and Intermediate)
- Ontario Student Record folders are starting to come in and are being reviewed by teachers
- Teachers are starting to do diagnostic assessments on students in the areas of Language and Math in particular (reading intervention programs will be starting soon based on the findings of reading diagnostics in particular Grade 3 will be targeted first term
- Individual reports for students who wrote Grade 3 or Grade 6 EQAO assessments during the 2018-2019 school year have arrived. These will be distributed to parents in the coming weeks (copy in the OSR as well). A general letter will be going out to all parents in the coming weeks as well. We did very well in Reading and Writing but Math will need to be a huge area of focus for us here as a school community
- Teachers will be starting to work on progress report cards soon

November 20th February 19<sup>th</sup> June 24<sup>th</sup>

- We will be continuing many of our school improvement focus areas from last year (making thinking visible) but will be more closely looking at what we can do to improve the numeracy skills of our students across all divisions
- Our cross panel planning day between our school and Jean Vanier took place during the week of September 16<sup>th</sup> (planning of activities to support the transition of our Grade 8 students to Jean Vanier Secondary School)
