Community Pop-up COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics Coming Soon



The Provincial Government will be operating two pop-up clinics in Oakville offering first doses of the Pfizer vaccine. The COVID-19 vaccine is an important tool to help us stop this pandemic. The vaccine protects you and helps build immunity across our community.

Location:

- St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Secondary School, 124 Dorval Dr. Oakville

Dates and Time:

- Saturday, June 19 from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Sunday, June 20 from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Eligible age groups:

- 12 years of age and older (must have had 12th birthday by the date of appointment).

How to book:

- Book your appointment online at [halton.ca/COVIDvaccines](https://www.halton.ca/COVIDvaccines) starting Wednesday June 16.
*(some walk-in appointments may be available; last walk-in appointment at 6 p.m.)

What to bring:

- Your health card
- A bottle of water

What to expect at your appointment:

- The pop-up clinic is outdoors. **Please come dressed for the weather.**
- You will be at the vaccine clinic for about 30 minutes.
- Please arrive 10 minutes prior (and not earlier) to your appointment for registration.
- Wear a mask at all times.
- Maintain a 2-metre physical distance from others at all times.
- If you require support, please only bring one person with you.
- Eat a meal or snack before your appointment.
